- Programme content that fully refreshes, updates and up-skills the participant

- A guarantee that a successful programme completer will be registered as a supply teacher by supply agencies that have endorsed the Teach Again Programme.

- Value for money – a participant can expect to progress to employment and earn a salary that will cover the cost of the course within two weeks.
- Support to cover the cost of fees – if you claim JSA or Universal Credit, the Job Centre may pay your fees. Speak to your local Job Centre to find out more. In addition, some supply agencies may reimburse applicant fees once the teacher has been employed by the agency for a set period.

On programme you will review, enhance and consolidate your skills, knowledge and understanding of successful practice in education. You'll benefit from the expertise of existing teachers and have the opportunity to develop your confidence as a professional practitioner. You will also become familiar with recent developments in education systems, methods and practices.

The Teach Again programme is designed to further your professional development, and help with new opportunities. It will give you the confidence to apply for teaching posts with the knowledge that you will be able to speak with recent and relevant experience
